




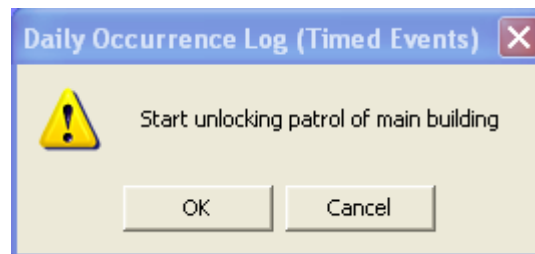
### Daily Occurrence Log Features:

## Extensive report capabilities

With the Site-Secure Report Builder, an almost infinite number of reports can be generated for data analysis and statistical reporting.
